

Registration Guide 2019 – Boca Raton Florida Porsche Parade

(April 10, 2019)

The 64th Porsche Parade will be held at the Boca Raton Resort and Club in Boca Raton, Florida Sunday July 21 – Saturday July 27, 2019. “Parade” last visited Florida in 2003.

The Boca Raton Resort & Club (A Waldorf Astoria Resort) sits on **356** acres with lush gardens and formal courtyards. The property has shuttle service every 15 minutes to the Boca Beach Club (there is a private ½ mile white sand beach you can enjoy) as well as a water taxi that is a fun diversion for Resort guests. There is a state-of-the-art Wave Simulator (first of its kind in Florida) at Flow Rider and it is well worth checking out. Have you ever seen a Champagne vending machine? Moët & Chandon has one that dispenses “splits” after inserting a token!

Prior to Registering

Please take the time to read through this registration document. It will help you to plan your events with your co-entrant before you register online.

Ensure you have an account for the member only portion at www.pca.org. **YOU WILL NEED TO LOGIN TO REGISTER FOR PARADE.** Check to see that all your information is correct, that your car information is up-to-date and especially your email address! A current contact phone number is also very important for Parade Week in case it is necessary to reach you. You will also want to be sure your cell phone number is correct—we will be using a texting app during Parade Week to receive event specific notifications and texts. All pre-Parade materials are sent to you via email, and/or are posted to the Parade website at www.porscheparade.org.

Before you register, at the very least, you will want to know:

- Your meal selections
- Volunteer selections and T-shirt sizes for volunteers
- Competitive event selection for each participant, and the class for each event
- Birthdates of all children attending
- Do you want to participate in any tours or other special events?
- If your co-entrant is another PCA member who is not your family/affiliate member, you will need to know their PCA membership number
- The license plate of the Porsche(s) you are bringing, along with the brand of tires
- If you are trailering, you will need to know the length of the trailer and the license plate state and number

Rules pertaining to the Parade and registering for Parade are outlined in the Parade Competition Rules (PCRs). The 2019 PCRs are available on the Parade Website (www.porscheparade.org).

Registration

Phase 2 (Banquets/Events) Registration for the 2019 Porsche Parade opens on Monday, April 15 at 12 Noon EDT. All registrations will be accepted but be aware some events fill quickly and then go to a “waitlist” status (it is clearly indicated on your registration, as well as the event fee. If the waitlist does not clear prior to registration close on June 23, you will receive a refund for that event).

When you register online, you must pay with an American Express, MasterCard or VISA in US funds. If you cannot register online, please call Kathleen Behrens at 503.579.3423 (PDT) to schedule a time to complete your registration after April 23, 2019.

All fees paid will be recorded and deposited at the time of registration.

Parade registrations are not transferable. Fifty percent (50%) of your registration fee and 100% of your banquet and event fees will be refunded if your emailed cancellation request to the Parade Registrar (registrar@pcaparade.org) is received on or before June 23, 2019. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR CANCELLATIONS MADE AFTER JUNE 23.** You may make changes to your registration at any time prior to June 23, 2019.

Registrations received after June 09 up to and including June 23 will be assessed a \$70 late fee.

Advance registration is mandatory—there is no onsite registration during Parade.

Registration Fees

Everyone signing up for the Parade must pay a registration fee of \$200, which covers the entrant and co-entrant. Entrants and co-entrants must be PCA members, but they need not be your co-member. This fee pays for your admittance to Parade, registration materials, one (1) Parade Bag, etc. Specific events may have additional fees. An entrant and co-entrant may each enter one car. Note that only Porsches as defined in the PCR’s may be registered.

JPP/CAFP entrants:	\$30/each
Child age 13 – 15:	\$25/each
Child under age 13:	\$25/each
Adult Guests:	\$65/each
Late Entrant Fee:	\$70

JPP (Junior Participant Program) entrants are the sons, daughters, nieces, nephews and grandchildren of PCA members who are 16 or 17 years old. CAFPP (College-Aged Family Program) entrants are the sons, daughters, nieces, nephews and grandchildren of PCA members who are 18 – 25 years old.

Other guests are welcome; however, only the entrant, co-entrant and JPP/CAFP entrants may enter the competitive events (except children ages 13 – 15 may register for the Technical Quiz). If other guests are PCA Members, they must submit their own registration and pay their own registration fee to enter the competitive events.

Competitive Event Fees:

\$45/per **Porsche** for Concours
\$30/per **Porsche** TSD Rally
\$45/per **driver** for Autocross
\$15/per **person** for Tech Quiz

Check-In

Registrants should check-in for Parade on Sunday, July 21 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM in the Mizner Center - Royal Palm Ballroom at the Boca Raton Resort (**no admittance after 4 PM**). This is the only time all the event chairs will be together to answer your questions as well as ensure you and your car are correctly classified for the competitive events. At Check-In you will have an opportunity to select seats for the two formal banquets if you haven't done so already, receive your name badges (required for entrance to all the activities) and obtain your Parade Bag.

Onsite Check-In is mandatory before participation in events, and there are deadlines for checking in prior to the competitive events. While limited late check-in is available during the week, the most fulfilling Parade experience begins with checking in on Sunday—and missing a deadline may mean you will not be able to compete. See the Parade Competition Rules for details.

Banquet Tickets

Select the banquets you wish to attend when you register, or any time prior to June 23. You may purchase a package for all the meals/food related events or you may purchase each individually. The package does not include children's (age 12 and under) meals, which must be purchased individually.

Vegetarian and special dietary needs meals will be available by special request.

Competitive Events

TSD Rally

Entrants, along with any other entrant or co-entrant, may participate in the Rally in any street-legal Porsche that is registered for the Parade.

Concours

Only the Porsche registered for Parade by the entrant or co-entrant may compete in the Concours.

Autocross

All Porsches entered in the Autocross must pass the Parade Autocross Safety Inspection. Entrants, co-entrant, JPP and CAFP entrants must drive the Porsches they have registered for the Parade, unless otherwise allowed by the PCRs.

Tech Quiz

Any entrant, co-entrant, registered child ages 13 – 15, JPP or CAFP entrant may compete in the Tech Quiz.

Banquets

All of the Banquets will be held indoors in the Grand Ballroom at the Mizner Center. There also will be two “open” evenings where you can enjoy a nice selection of options available at the Resort, the surrounding towns or consider taking a dinner cruise.

Concours and Victory banquet attendees will be pre-assigned at tables by regions. Small regions will be grouped with another region from their own zone to the extent possible. You will not need to go to the Banquet Seating Assignment Station during Check-In. If you prefer the “traditional” manner for seat/tablemate selection (you will need to go to the Banquet Seating Assignment Station during Check-In), be sure to check the box when completing your online registration.

Reserved Seating: You will be able to choose pre-assigned region tables during online registration OR you can choose your own seat and tablemates during Check-In on Sunday, July 21. Dress: Cocktail Attire. Cost: \$80 adults.

Wednesday, July 24 – The Porsche Design TSD Rally Awards Dinner: The German themed Buffet will feature Field of Greens with assorted dressings; Sliced Beefsteak Tomatoes with Herbs and Oil, Pickles & Sours, Chicken Schnitzel, Braised Red Cabbage with Vinegar; Brats and Sausage Station with Sauerkrauts, Caramelized Onions , Peppers and Potato Buns; Oven Roasted Root Vegetables, Apple, Cabbage Spaetzle; Kartoffelpuffer (Potato Cake), Apple Sauce, Pretzel Haus Station with Coarse Salted Pretzels and Mini Soft Nuggets, Cheddar & Beer Fondue, Assorted Mustards; 3 Foot Strudels (Cherry and Apple), Vanilla Ice Cream & Caramel Sauce, German Chocolate Brownie with Fudge Glaze; Brewed Coffee and selection of Teas. Cash Bars will be available. Open Seating. Dress: German or Porsche Attire. Cost: \$65 adults/\$35 children age 6 -12; age 5 and under no charge.

Friday, July 26 – The Michelin Autocross Awards and Parade Kids Recognition Dinner: The Buffet Menu: Ambrosia Fruit Salad, Assorted Mixed Greens with Ranch and Italian Dressing, Chicken Chorizo Paella, Ham and Pineapple Pizza, Macaroni and Cheese; Carrot Cake, Chocolate Chocolate Cake, Brewed Coffee and selection of Teas. Cash Bars will be available. Open Seating. Dress: 1970s Attire. Cost: \$65 adults/\$35 children age 6 – 12; age 5 and under no charge.

Saturday, July 26 – The Reliable Carriers Victory Awards Banquet: The 66th Porsche Parade location will be revealed and we will hear from our newly elected PCA President. The annual winner for the “Trip to Germany” prize will be chosen. The menu highlights: Fingers of Romaine, Warm Parmesan Twists, Cracked Black Pepper, Caesar Dressing; Brasserie Spring Chicken in Red Wine, Wild Mushroom Pan Jus; Buttered Cauliflower Puree, Aged Goat Cheese Potato Au Gratin, Oven Roasted Broccolini, Parsnips and Carrots; Dulce Milk Chocolate Tort, Crunchy Chocolate Croquant; Brewed Coffee and selection of Teas. Vegetarian Option available upon request. Cash Bars will be available. Reserved Seating: You will be able to choose pre-assigned region tables during online registration OR you can choose your own seat and tablemates during Check-In on Sunday, July 21. Dress: Cocktail Attire. Cost: \$70 adults.

Vegetarian alternatives are available for the two plated meals--Concours and Victory Banquets. Order these, or list any other special dietary requests, when you complete online registration.

There will be a **Concours Box Lunch** available at the Mizner Center on Monday, July 22 with a choice of a Turkey Sandwich with Lettuce and Tomato on a roll or a Veggie Wrap with Cucumber, Red Pepper, Zucchini, Romaine with Hummus. Both include individual bag of chips, 1 piece of whole fruit and one bottled water. Dress: Very Casual. Cost: \$25.

Last minute scheduling changes for Parade Week are announced at the banquet closest to the event affected.

Trophies are not shipped and need to be picked up at the event banquet or at the Parade Information Desk through Friday afternoon.

Remember, to be eligible for an evening’s door prizes, you must register for that banquet and be present to win!

The Banquet Meal Package (includes the five evening banquets and Concours box lunch) price is \$375.

Porsche Concours d’ Elegance – Monday, July 22 (\$45 per car)

This is the premiere Porsche Parade competition event. This year, the Concours d’ Elegance will be held on the picturesque 10th and 18th fairways of the Boca Raton Golf Club at the Boca Raton Resort and Club. Concours will host over 200 Concours Porsches, as well as the Heritage & Historic Display of unique and rare Porsches. Class Awards will be presented at the Porte Cochere in front of the Mizner Center adjacent to the Concours Field. Group, Level of Achievement, People’s Choice, and Honorary Judges Awards will be presented at the Concours Banquet.

Introduced for 2019 is a new Preservation Class for “Low Mileage” Porsches. Be sure to review the 2019 Parade Competition Rules prior to registration to determine the correct judging class in which your Porsche should be entered.

A dedicated floor in the Parking Garage adjoining the Mizner Center at the Resort will be set aside Concours Prep. This level will be secure and exclusive for Concours participants only. This facility will be available starting Friday, July 19th at 8 am on a first-come first-served basis. It is recommended you should be prepared to have an additional light source. The Car Wash area is adjacent to the Parking Garage.

- “Concours 101” is a one-hour technical session focused primarily for new or aspiring Concours entrants. The briefing includes protocol, rules, what to expect and some helpful preparation techniques along with handouts. The two sessions during the week are scheduled for Saturday July 20 at 5 pm and Sunday July 21 at 7 am in Mizner Center—please check the schedule on the Parade Website for the designated Meeting Room at the Resort.

TSD Rally – Tuesday, July 23 (\$30 per car)

The Porsche Design TSD Rally will take you around the scenic roads in the central Florida area in a rally sharpened for your driving pleasure. It will delight the novice and challenge the rally experts! The countryside is interesting and there are no twisty roads, mountain roads, or hills! It will take about four hours to run including a midpoint break (gas and restrooms) and spans approximately 120 miles. You will be back in time for the start of the traditional ice cream social! Whether you have never rallied before or just want a refresher, be sure to attend the TSD Rally School on Monday, July 22. Our TSD Rally School is designed for the novice and taught by past TSD Rally champions. You will learn about the rally, what to bring, tips for staying on time, along with rally generals (the rules of the event and how to use them), terminology, how to fill out a score sheet and what to do at a checkpoint (control).

Only the entrant or co-entrant who is bringing the rally Porsche should register for the rally. Parade Guests are not allowed to compete in this event. The “PCA Juniors” program is different from PCA JPP—and those under the age of 16 are not allowed to participate. Status of entrants for the TSD Rally will be verified. If you are driving or navigating another Parade entrant’s Porsche, the other entrant must register for the rally and include your name on their rally registration. Junior Participation Program (JPP) members may not drive in the Rally but may navigate with either of their sponsoring PCA member driving. College Age Family Program (CAFP) members may either drive or navigate in the rally. Be sure to see the current Parade Competition Rules (PCRs) for definitions of the current rally classes offered (with the addition of a new Tech Equip Rally Class, there are now six). The use of GPS Navigation systems (both factory and portable) has been clarified. **Entrants are responsible for classifying their own vehicle.**

Michelin Autocross – Wednesday and Thursday, July 24 and 25 (\$45 per person)

The Autocross will be held at the Palm Beach International Raceway, approximately 50 miles from the Boca Raton Resort. Part of the actual racetrack will be utilized for the Autocross course.

Watch the Parade website for comments on the course and site conditions.

Set aside 3:30 – 5:30 pm on Tuesday, July 23 for the Autocross Chalk Talk and course walk at the Autocross site—there will be an analysis of the course and a chance to learn tips and techniques. The course will also be open on Wednesday, July 24 from 7:15 – 8:00 am and on Thursday, July 25 from 7:15 – 8:00 am for course walks.

NEW THIS YEAR: Each driver must sign up to work during Autocross. You will work either in the morning or the afternoon of your run group day.

There is a new “Novice Class” for beginning Parade Autocross entrants.

All Porsches entered in the Autocross must pass the Parade Safety Technical Inspection. The Safety Inspection will be done at the Autocross site on Grid from 7 – 9 am/11 am – 2 pm on both Autocross days. Please take a few minutes to look at the PCA Tech Inspection form on the Parade website prior to arriving at Parade to ensure you are in compliance! If you are competing in Autocross, you are responsible for all items on the Safety Inspection form prior to your run group.

Registered Junior Participation Program (JPP) members and College Age Family Program (CAFP) members with a valid driver's license may participate in the autocross in the same Porsche and same as the parent(s).

The run schedule for Wednesday will be S1 – S13. The run schedule for Thursday will be S-14, S-15, P1 – P17, I01 – I05, M01 – M05, Novice. Be sure to check the Parade website for complete details.

Study the PCRs to determine the proper autocross class to enter. There are separate classes for men and for women, so be sure to choose appropriately. Be aware there is an Open Class and a Ladies Class—women can choose which class they wish to run in. **It is your responsibility to correctly classify your Porsche.**

Gimmick Rally – Thursday, July 25 (\$25 per car)

“Spring Break Gimmick Rally” will take you to a variety of unique destinations that showcase the Fort Lauderdale and Pompano Beach area, with something for everyone! Classic Porsches, classic ocean beaches, historic houses, antique cars, famous race cars...even ice cream! The route is easy and will take approximately 4 hours to complete, at a distance of 60 – 70 miles. At each destination you will solve some clues and answer questions—then you can choose to stay and explore or drive on to the next destination. If you choose to tour some of the very interesting locations, be aware some require an entry fee. There is no charge for parking at all destinations with the exception of the Fort Lauderdale beaches (average \$10 parking fee).

During Parade Check-In, you will choose your competition class (either Two-Person or Two-Plus Passengers) depending upon the number of people in your vehicle (**minimum of two**). You may enter as a pair, a family or join in with friends; and **you may drive a Porsche, rental car, tow vehicle or “other” but it must have as many seat belts as passengers.** You also can change your class if your plans change during Parade Week. **ONLY the DRIVER should register for this event.**

NOTE: PCA insurance restrictions prohibit participation by anyone who is NOT registered for Parade. Thus, you cannot have a friend or family member, adult or minor, “ride along” unless they are registered. There will be no exceptions.

Technical and Historical Quiz – Friday, July 26 (\$15 per person)

The Technical and Historical Quiz will be a written test of your knowledge of general, mechanical, and historic aspects of the Porsche family, business and model lines. You will be able to test your knowledge with questions from the PCA Tech Committee.

There will be 50 General questions that will be the same of all participants, 25 additional questions for Specific Model Ranges (you choose which model) and 5 Tiebreaker questions for everyone that will NOT count in your score but will only be used to settle tie scores if they occur. For the Overall Awards the

score will be weighted toward the General History and Technical questions; for the Model Specific Awards the score will be weighted toward the Model Specific questions.

The questions will be multiple choice and true/false. The bibliography of publications used for the questions will be posted on the Parade website two months prior to Parade. Allotted Quiz Time: 90 minutes.

Art Show (\$25 per adult/Children under 12 no charge)

All Parade entrants who are artists, crafters and Porsche aficionados are invited to participate in the Art Show at Boca Raton—what a great opportunity to share your creative side with other Parade attendees. There are 17 categories you can choose from, based on your experience and expression. Seasoned judges select the leading achievements in each category, besides the Best of Show and People’s Choice Awards. Art Show Entrants will be honored with a Wine and Cheese Reception.

Complete guidelines, rules and entrant application will be available on the Parade website.

Volunteers

Volunteers are the formula to make the Parade a success—you help to make this extraordinary week run smoothly. In fact, our Parade is 99% volunteer supported! Every Parade event needs volunteers and volunteering is a wonderful way to meet other PCA members and to share in the fun and energy of Parade.

By volunteering to work at the Parade, you will receive a specially designed shirt to be worn while you work. When you complete a shift, please have your Volunteer Worker card stamped. A shift is between 3 to 6 hours, normally a morning (AM), mid-day (MD) or an afternoon (PM) shift. Work two shifts and you will be qualified to attend the Volunteer Party on Saturday, July 27 which includes time for socializing, and door prizes! It is a thank-you for being a Parade Volunteer Worker as a registered entrant! Children 14 years of age and over can volunteer for most events with the permission of their parents and at the discretion of the event chair.

General description of responsibilities within each event:

5K Run/Walk: Assist with setup, ensure participants stay on course, post-event cleanup.

Art Show: Help receive and secure artwork, write receipts, and monitor the room. Remove displays and close out the Art Show at the end of the event.

Autocross: Set up the course, grid, work course, assist timing/scoring, handout supplies, assist final tech, control traffic, and post-event cleanup.

Banquets: Set up and decorate for the banquets, take tickets, post-event cleanup.

Car Wash: Maintain car wash areas supplies.

Concours: Field layout, car placement, field marshals, traffic control, runners/timers, scoring, post event-cleanup.

Concours Prep: Assist with organizing car cleaning area for Concours participants and general Parade participants.

Driving Tours: Driving Tours Leaders, Driving Tour Sweepers, and Bus Tour Marshals needed.

Equipment: Assist with delivery, placement and collection of supplies for events and post-event cleanup.

Gimmick Rally: Assist at start tent, collect score sheets, scoring.

Parade Store: Setup/take down displays, cash register checkout, counter help, sales help, stocking, inventory, door duty, packing, post-event cleanup.

Heritage and Historic Display: Car placement and monitor the participants viewing the classic street/racing cars.

Hospitality: Greet/assist entrants, provide information, and serve snacks/drinks.

Michelin Drive and Compare: Assist with course setup, work grid/corners, traffic control and post-event cleanup.

Parade Check-In: Check-in registered entrants, work at various event stations, handout Parade bags, assign banquet seating.

Parade Info Desk: Answer questions and direct participants.

Parade Kids: Assist in setup and running of Parade Kid activities. Background Check required for first-time volunteers; details on Parade Kids and Volunteers on the Parade website.

Parking Control: Direct vehicles to correct parking/staging areas.

RC Car Race: Assist with course setup, event management and post-event cleanup.

Safety/Tech Inspection: Perform Autocross safety checks.

Technical Quiz: Greet entrants, handout quiz, monitor, quiz collection, scoring.

Tech Sessions: Assist speakers, monitor/work AV equipment, help with refreshments.

TSD Rally: Checkpoint/control workers, starting, finishing, staging, scoring.

Water/Ice: Assist with delivery for events.

Welcome Tent: Greet/assist entrants as they arrive.

Parade Kids (\$30 additional fee per child)

2019 Parade Kids promises to be a fun-filled adventure for the whole family. There are so many things to do on-site and great activities planned—all kids and juniors are welcome to join in accompanied by their parents.

Here are some of the activities (both old and new) planned: Miniature Car Concours (paint a wooden toy car and enter for a People's Choice Award and a Best in Show voted on by Parade Kids), Make and Take Crafts, Any Cross Competition (using anything that rolls), RC Cars (bring your own or borrow ours), Hagerty Youth Judging, Ice Cream Social (build your own sundae), T-Shirt and Tote Design Contest (winning entries will be used for PKids T-Shirt and Tote at Parade 2020), 5K Walk/Run, Kids Tech Quiz, and Gimmick Rally. We also will have "Little Kid (Age 9 and under)" and "Big Kid (Age 10 - 17)" activities planned.

We are again offering "Kids Camp/Childcare" during the Concours and Victory Banquets that includes games and activities, movies and a kid-friendly meal for \$40 per child per evening. Childcare is offered exclusively for parents attending the Concours/Victory Banquets for children 18 months – 12 years.

During the Welcome Party, Rally Banquet and Autocross Banquet, there will be a Parade Kids Table to capture some fun time with activities.

The ever-popular “Family Fun Night” evening will be on Thursday, July 25 from 5:30 – 8:30 PM (although you may stay and play until 2 AM) at the Silverball Museum in Delray Beach (approximately 10 miles; transportation is not provided). Parents are invited too! \$25 per child/adult includes gaming and dinner buffet.

Each child registered for Parade Kids will receive their own special T-Shirt and child bag along with a Parade medal.

Hospitality

Please come and experience Porsche Parade Hospitality during Parade Week at Boca Raton! Besides being able to enjoy a warm beverage or a cool drink, there will be snacks appropriate to the time of the day—early or midday. You will be able to connect in this meeting space with friends old or new, put together or add a piece or two to a puzzle, color (one of the latest crazes that tends to be relaxing) or what have you. You will at least want to stop by and pick up your daily raffle ticket—which gives you a chance to win interesting Porsche Parade items from past years!

Our wonderful array of Parade Sponsors will have their booths awaiting your arrival with displays, information, handouts and giveaways—always a highlight!

Plan on stopping by after the day’s events to check event scores or find an extra event ticket on “The Board”. This is where available tickets from registered entrants are posted for sale.

Beer Tasting – Wednesday, July 24, 2:00 – 4:30 PM (\$35 per person)

The RC Car competition will have two events:

1. RC On-Road Track Race on Tuesday, July 23

Driving Tours
